# Call for a PhD student to do a traineeship in EPSO

# Focus of the traineeship: RESEARCH AND INNOVATION Programme / FUNDS ANALYSES

EPSO is looking for a PhD student in life sciences to do a traineeship in EPSO starting preferably in September 2020. The traineeship is normally carried out <u>remotely</u>. However, subject to availability of desk facilities the trainee might be offered to join the EPSO team <u>in the EPSO office</u>, which would be announced before the start of the traineeship. Preference will be given to candidates from EPSO member institutions (<u>www.epsoweb.org/membership/members</u>).

The ideal candidate will have previous knowledge and experience, <u>or</u> a strong interest in European programmes such as Horizon 2020 / Horizon Europe, LIFE, ERASMUS+ or Structural funds.

#### **TASKS**

Analysis of EU programmes / funds relevant to research and innovation (R&I) in plant science Elaboration of EPSO briefings tailored to plant scientists based on the findings Monitoring of future funding opportunities for R&I in plant science Preparation of guotes and messages about R&I in plant science for science communication

## **REQUIREMENTS**

PhD candidate in a field relevant to plant science: biological, agricultural or food sciences Excellent level of spoken and written English Analytical mind and attention to detail Outstanding writing skills
Fundamental computer skills

## **CONDITIONS**

Grant / scholarship: mandatory only for office-based trainees who should have all their costs covered Insurance: both remote and office-based trainees must be covered by their home institution Availability: start anytime in September 2020

Duration of the traineeship: between three to six months

Co-authoring EPSO publications (briefings and analyses) about European funding programmes tailored to plant scientists

Valuable knowledge of the available funds for R&I in life sciences essential for a future researcher Unique working experience in a European organization
